Landscape Painting Intensive in Southern France - Art 275-105 Special Topics

The workshop will be taught by Ian Roberts and Marsha Wooley. The first part of the 10-day workshop will be taught in Le Barroux, a small medieval village perched on a rocky outcrop and dominated by a 12th century chateau. The richly articulated landscape is like a cross between Provence and the Chianti region of Tuscany with its vineyards, olive groves, and cypress.

Then we will travel to Paris for 4 1/2 days where we will cover historical and aesthetic painting concerns with visits to historical sites and museums.

In this workshop you will learn to:

- Edit the intricacies of nature into a single, powerful image.
- Block in accurate value masses which forms the basis of a solid and aesthetic composition.
- Create rich color as it relates to temperature and saturation.
- Have a wonderful experience visiting museums and monuments in Paris.
- Develop insight as to how to critique one's own artwork.
